TRAINING FOR INCUMBENT WORKERS

Incumbent Worker Training (IWT) is a type of work-based training and upskilling designed to ensure that California workers can acquire and develop the skills necessary to succeed in the local workforce and maintain employment.

TRAINING METODS

Didactic

Formal instruction provided in a classroom setting. Training is provided regularly, under the direct guidance of a qualified trainer.

Instructor-Led Video Conference

Training is conducted in a virtual environment utilizing a Zoom-based platform (with designated start and end times). Training is a real-time interactive class session with an instructor. Trainees interact with instructor/students during class via computer monitor (i.e. audio, visual, or computer generated messages).
